



Victorian High Point and Triple Crown Awards 2011/2012

- To take part in the Victorian High Point Awards you must have a performance card for each section you wish to enter. The cost of the first card purchased is \$10.00; each subsequent card purchased at the same time is \$5.00. Junior sections are \$5.00 per card.
- If a pony entered in one of the High Point sections is sold, the card may be transferred to the new owner and must be returned to the High Point Co-Ordinator to be updated. Once updated, the High Point Co-ordinator will return the card to the new owner.
- It is the responsibility of the owner/junior to indicate the show, date, class and result accurately – PLEASE ENTER THE INFORMATION CLEARLY AS ILLEGIBLE ENTRIES WILL NOT BE COUNTED.
- It is also the owner's responsibility to obtain the signature of the steward or judge ON THE DAY OF THE SHOW to verify the results. The Australian Miniature Pony Society Victorian State Delegate may also sign to verify the result, ONLY IF THEY ATTENDED THE SHOW ON THAT DAY.
- The best six shows for each card will determine your High Point Awards calculation.
- Only Victorian ponies registered with the Australian Miniature Pony Society and registered owners/handlers can enter.
- When applying for your card/s, please choose which section/s you wish to enter. You MUST enter all other information as indicated.
- Points may be gained at any Victorian Agricultural Shows, Victorian Equine Shows run under AMPS rules, Young Stock Show (Young Stock classes only), Melbourne Summer Royal, Australian Miniature Pony of the Year, and Victorian Feature Shows. The Triple Chance Show will be counted as three separate shows for the purpose of the High Point Awards. Where there are no yearling classes at a show, points may be gained in the available age class (e.g. 3 years and under for yearlings/2 year olds).
- Points will only be awarded to Child Handlers for their respective handler classes, and excludes fancy dress and ridden classes.
- Points will only be awarded to Harness ponies for their main harness classes (ie Mare, Gelding, Stallion) and excludes pleasure pony, period costume, etc.
- Points will only be awarded to Drivers for their main driver classes (ie Lady / Gentleman / Senior Driver)

Points will be allocated as follows:

First place	4 points	Champion	2 points
Second place	3 points	Supreme	2 points
Third place	2 points	Best Exhibit	2 points
Fourth place	1 point	Reserve Champion	1 point
Best Child Handler	2 points	Grand Champion	1 point

The categories are as follows:

VICTORIAN TRIPLE CROWN

Yearling Colt	Colt 2 and 3 years
Yearling Filly	Filly 2 and 3 years
Yearling Gelding	Gelding 2 and 3 years
Stallion 4 years and over	Harness Mare (3 years and over)
Mare 4 years and over	Harness Gelding (3 years and over)
Gelding 4 years and over	Harness Stallion (3 years and over)
Junior Handler 6 years and under	Senior Driver (18 years and over)
Junior Handler 7 to 11 years	Junior Driver (17 years and under)
Junior Handler 12 to 17 years	

- You may begin earning your points as of 1 August 2011 and all cards must be returned NO LATER than 5:00pm 31 May 2012.
- YOU MUST SEND A STAMPED SELF-ADDRESSED ENVELOPE FOR RETURN OF YOUR CARDS. Please also allow a five day turnaround for your cards; please do not call me on Wednesday or Thursday wanting cards for the following weekend's shows!
- In the past, there has been some confusion as to which shows qualify and which shows do not. If in doubt, fill in the show anyway as I have a list of those shows that qualify, or give me a call.



Victorian Triple Crown Awards 2011/2012

- If you wish to enter the Victorian Triple Crown Award as well as High Point, the cost is \$5 per card if you just want to enter the Triple Crown the cost will be \$10 per card
- Please circle below as indicated and I will send out a card with your High-Point cards.
- To be eligible, you must compete in the Led Classes at any of the three (3) out of the four (4) Promotional Group Shows these are the Westernport Promotional Group Show, The Central Goldfields Promotional Group Show, The Geelong Promotional Group Show and the Gippsland Promotional Group Show.

Requirements to enter the Victorian High-Point Awards 2011/2012 and the Victorian Triple Crown Awards for 2011/2012

BEFORE SENDING YOUR INFORMATION, PLEASE CHECK THAT YOU HAVE:

1. Completed all the information as required on the application form above;
2. Indicated which category/ies you wish to enter, including the Victorian Triple Crown Award;
3. Included a stamped, self-addressed business sized envelope for up to three cards, an A5 envelope for four or more cards;
4. Payment (please make cheques payable to Australian Miniature Pony Society);
5. Included a copy of both sides of the pony's registration form. Please remember that any pony aged two (2) years and over **MUST** be adult registered; please forward a copy of the adult registration as soon as the upgrade has been completed;
6. Included a copy of your 2011/2012 membership card;
7. Any applications that are not filled in correctly will be returned.

Payment must accompany application form. The cost of the first card purchased is \$10.00; each subsequent card purchased at the same time is \$5.00. Junior handler sections are \$5.00 per card.
