## THE SOUTHERN STARS - CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. **NO DOGS** allowed on the grounds. This will be enforced.
2. The lodging of any entry shall bind the exhibitor to the conditions of entry and the regulations set out herein and the signature of any exhibitor on the entry form shall constitute acceptance of these conditions.
3. SA ARABS Inc committee shall have the power without consigning any reason to:
  - a) Combine Classes
  - b) Alter at any time the scheduled event or class starting times
  - c) Remove any exhibitor from the show grounds for displaying abuse towards their horse/s
4. Age group classes in any ring may be combined. Derivative horse/pony registries and sexes maybe combined. Purebred age group classes may also be combined
5. Stallions and colts will not be permitted to be handled, ridden or driven by any person under 18 years whilst on the show grounds
6. Ridden horses are to be 4 years of age or over
7. The Southern Stars show will be conducted under these rules and the ARABIAN HORSE SOCIETY OF AUSTRALIA LIMITED RULE BOOK 2007.
8. **ARABIAN RING ONLY. All horses** competing **must be registered** with the Arabian Horse Society of Australia. Registration numbers **MUST** be quoted on the entry form. A photo copy of the registration certificate **MUST** accompany entries. Pending registrations are not acceptable. Ages of the horses/ponies are referenced to the 1<sup>st</sup> August convention. All horses, excluding foals, must be able to be identified by their brands and or markings in accordance with the Certification of Registration issued by the Society. Change of coat colour or adding white markings is prohibited and may result in disqualification.
9. SA ARABS Inc. shall not be held responsible for loss of or damage or injury occasioned to any exhibitor or to the property of any exhibitor or to the property of any exhibitor for any cause what so ever.
10. Only one handler per horse in each class with the exception of Supreme events
11. All horses entered must comply with the AHSA regulations and all horses excluding foals must be able to be identified by their brands and or markings in accordance with the Certificate of Registration issued by the Society. Change of coat colour or adding white markings is prohibited and may result in disqualification.
12. The exhibitor and exhibits enter entirely at their own risk. In the case of any exhibit, whilst on the grounds, causing or being the cause of injury or damage to any other exhibitor shall be liable to SA ARABS Inc, its officers, officials and members for any damage or loss occasioned to any of them by the exhibit or exhibitor or agent.
13. Entry fees will not be refunded for any reason.
14. Photocopy of BOTH SIDES of exhibits registration papers MUST accompany entry form and fees (this includes Dual Registered exhibits), otherwise entry will not be accepted.
15. Exhibitors will not be allowed to enter the ring once judging has commenced.
16. Verbal or physical abuse to judges, officers, committee members or stewards shall result in instant disqualification of all exhibits entered by the offending exhibitor or handler. Any horse which in the opinion of the judge has been subjected to abuse will not be judged.
17. **PROTESTS:** The following persons may lodge a protest - Competitors or Exhibitors in the disputed class or any show official. The protest must be lodged within ONE HOUR of the completion of the event or class. Protests must be accompanied by \$50.00 cash, refundable if the protest is upheld
18. **DISPUTES COMMITTEE:** The disputes Committee will be made up of the following:  
**One Committee Member -The Show Manager and/or Ring Master-One Competitor.**  
No Member of the committee may hear a protest in a Section of the show in which he/she is exhibiting or competing. The judge of the section concerned may be consulted. The decision of the committee is final and binding.

19. **STIRRING:** Exhibits are not to be excessively stirred-up. Horses must remain calmly in the marshalling area with a maximum of one handler/rider and one groom. No devices, artificial gadgets or loud noises shall be used to excite waiting horses. This rule also applies to other persons on the outside of the ring or marshalling areas. Exhibits who are excessively excited maybe asked to leave the ring or marshalling area and will not be judged. Persons failing to obey this rule may have their exhibit disqualified from the class. Handlers are not to incite stallions to challenge by facing them up to each other or crowding them. The facing up of stallions is strictly prohibited. **WHIP ABUSE OF ANY KIND WILL NOT BE TOLERATED.**
20. The Judge's decision is final
21. **INSURANCE:** All Exhibitors/handlers/grooms/riders who are Members of the Arabian Horse Society of Australia (or any of its affiliates) and Equestrian Australia must complete the AHSA Liability Declaration. A copy of the current Membership Card must also be submitted with entries.  
All Exhibitors handlers/grooms/riders who **are not members** of the AHSA (or any of its Affiliates) must complete the Registered Participant Agreement and pay the "Day Insurance Fee" of \$10.
22. **NO ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED IF PROOF OF MEMBERSHIP IS NOT PROVIDED OR DAY INSURANCE IS NOT PAID. ALL PERSONS WHO WILL BE HANDLING HORSES MUST HAVE INSURANCE COVERAGE.**
23. **ANY HORSE ENTERED MAY BE SUBJECT TO RANDOM DRUG SWABBING.**
24. All Bio security guidelines must be followed. In the event of a standstill being called, the owner/rider will be responsible for all costs involved in maintaining their horse/s on the site for the duration of the standstill.

## Horse Sports are a Dangerous Activity

In consideration for being permitted to participate in any way in horse sport activities and in particular this event, I, the undersigned, understand, acknowledge and accept that:

Horse sports are a dangerous recreational activity and horses can act in a sudden and unpredictable (changeable) way, especially if frightened or hurt.

There is a significant risk that serious **INJURY** or **DEATH** may result from horse sport activities and in particular this event.

I knowingly and freely assume all such risks, both known and unknown, even if arising from the negligence of the proprietors of the Arabian Horse Society of Australia Ltd and/or the event organiser (hereafter referred to as the "Releasees") or others and I voluntarily **PARTICIPATE** at my **OWN RISK** and assume sole responsibility for any injury, death or property damage I may suffer that arises from my participation in horse sport activities.

I understand and acknowledge the dangers associated with the consumption of alcohol or any mind altering drugs before and during the activity and I take full responsibility for any injury, loss or damage associated with their consumption. I agree not to drink alcohol or take drugs prohibited by law before or during this event.

I agree to follow the directions of any event organiser or official and that any misconduct or refusal by me to follow any direction of any organiser or official can result in the **CANCELLATION** of my participation in the event and my immediate removal from my horse **NO MATTER** where that may occur. I further agree to abide by the Rules and Conditions of this show and the official Rule Book of the Arabian Horse Society of Australia. I understand that any such non-compliance may result in injury, death and/or permanent disability and I agree to indemnify the Releasees against all claims made by any person as a result of my failure to comply.

I agree to wear a helmet at all times whilst riding and agree that I am solely responsible for ensuring that I wear a suitable helmet at all times while riding and take sole responsibility for my actions.

I, for myself and on behalf of my heirs, assigns, personal representatives and next of kin, hereby release and hold harmless and agree not to sue the proprietors of the Arabian Horse Society of Australia Ltd and/or the event organiser, their officers, officials, volunteers, coaches, agents and/or employees, other participants, sponsoring agencies, sponsors, state bodies, affiliated clubs and if applicable, owners and lessors of premises used to conduct the activities (all of whom are referred to as "Releasees") with respect to any and all injury, disability, death, or loss or damage to person or property, whether caused by the negligence of the releasees or otherwise.

I understand that due to diseases such as equine influenza, the Department of Primary Industries, or other state or commonwealth government bodies may restrict or prevent the movement of horses, vehicles and personnel for a time period, otherwise known as a "standstill". I acknowledge that a standstill is a risk of competing and agree to pay any costs or expenses incurred by any person or organisation for and on behalf of my horse(s) as a result of the standstill.

**Effect of this Document** - I have had sufficient opportunity to read this release of liability and assumption of risk agreement, fully understand its terms, understand that I have given up substantial rights by signing it, and sign it freely and voluntarily without inducement of any kind. I understand that my signature to this document constitutes a complete and unconditional release of all liability of the Releasees, to the greatest extent allowed by law in the event of me and/or the children under my care, suffering injury or death.
