Great little cross country course with around 25 Grade 5 and a number of Grade 4 jumps. Cross country jumps will be flagged.

Good variety of jumps, including banks, trakhener, drop, stone wall, picnic table, log pile, ditch, trough, wine barrels etc. Jumps range from very easy to quite challenging.

There will also be an opportunity to practice your Show Jumping on a supervised course. The starting height will be 45 cm at 8 am. It will remain at that height for the first hour, then raised as required.

Competitors may participate in Cross Country and Show Jumping in either order.

But wait, there's more – we will also have a dressage arena erected so that you can practice a test.

And when you are done and dusted, and feeling a bit peckish, we will even have some catering available – egg & bacon sandwiches, cake, tea, coffee and cold drinks.



#### CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:

Entries will be accepted on a first come, first served basis, so get those entries in early to get the time slot of your choice.
