General Rules:

Entering this competition constitutes acknowledgement that PCAV rules apply and acceptance of these rules.

Pony Club Riders: No Rally Card = Elimination. Cards must be handed in at Secretaries Office before riding. All entrants are responsible for their own cards: see *Club Member Cards Guidelines* in the 'publications, rules and regulations' section of the PCAV website.

Dressage will commence at 9am sharp, please be on time.

Gear check is compulsory for before each phase.

Vet check at finish of cross country phase.

All competitors should have their own ambulance cover. (Open riders should also have their own personal accident cover)

Open riders will be required to submit a day attendance form before riding and pay the \$10 fee with entries.

The committee reserves the right to cancel any class or event, alter the advertised times or refuse entry, with or without stating the reason.

Dogs allowed, must be kept on a leash at all times.

No refunds after entry closing date.

Riders may enter in Horse Trials AND Two Phase events on the same horse, but will use the same Dressage and Show Jumping results. Combinations must enter in their HT grade.

Falls: A fall in Show Jumping or Cross Country = elimination. A rider who has a fall from their horse anywhere on the venue during any part of the competition or while warming up MUST have their medical fitness assessed under the rules outlined in the PCAV Handbook of Bylaws 24.1 before taking any further part in the competition.

Facilities: Powered camping sites are available, sorry no showers. Camping fees \$10 per family. Please advise intention to stay overnight. Yards available on request, \$5 per yard, all yards to be left clean. Yards will be allocated prior to arrival.

Catering: Sunday breakfast, morning tea, lunch and drinks available from the club rooms.

Presentations: To 1st - 6th place getters will be made un-mounted but they must wear full club uniform. (Open riders to be in Show-jumping attire.)

Protests: Queries and protests must be submitted within 20 minutes of results being posted. Protests must be in writing, signed by DC or their delegate and accompanied by \$20 fee. There is no fee for submitting a query.

Liability: Neither the MAPC Inc, Mildura Horse Complex Inc, Board of Management or PCAV accept any liability for any accident, injury, loss or illness to any horse, rider, owner, spectator or any other persons involved what so ever.

Open: Pony Club and Non-Pony Club riders are eligible for this class (nil grading or membership required). Riders to nominate their grade (1-5), with a 10 point penalty for each grade lowered from Grade 1. Open riders will participate in the same dressage test and then follow on behind Pony Club competitors in their respective grades for XC and SJ. Day attendance forms are compulsory for all Open entries (including PC members) and must accompany entries. Forms are available from the PCAV website: www.ponyclubvic.org.au under 'Resources'. Pony Club members do not need to pay the \$10 fee if their card is presented. PCAV Alcohol Policy applies.

Multiple Horses: More than one horse may be ridden subject to the conditions of PCAV Handbook of By-laws multiple horse rules.

Horse Abuse: Will not be tolerated! Excessive or inappropriate use of whip, spurs or bit will result in immediate disqualification in accordance with PCAV's Handbook of By-Laws. Horse Abuse also includes, but is not limited to, riding an obviously lame horse, riding an exhausted horse and dangerous riding i.e. excessive speeds. It is the responsibility of the rider to be familiar with PCAV's policy on horse abuse and strictly abide by it.

Lungeing: - Lungeing at this competition must take place in the confined area designated exclusively for lungeing: the round yard. At a competition only the competitor may ride or lunge his horse or pony. The penalty for disobeying this rule is elimination.
